The TCC Non-Resident Tuition Waiver is a waiver of the non-resident portion of tuition for up to six (6) credit hours for the Fall and/or Spring semesters. Applicants will be awarded as funds are available and funding is not guaranteed. Should the number of qualified applicants exceed the number of waivers available, applications will be considered in the order they are received.

Eligibility Criteria

- Degree Seeking from Tulsa Community College
- Academic Requirements:
 - First-time entering Freshmen: high school graduate or completed high school equivalency
 - Transfer Students: 2.5 GPA
 - Continuing TCC Students: 2.5 retention GPA (the cumulative GPA on your TCC transcript)
- Complete a 2026-27 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)
- Be eligible under TCC’s financial aid Satisfactory Academic Progress policy
- Meet Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education criteria for a non-resident waiver of tuition (policy available at www.okhighered.org)
- Must have not attempted more than 95 total credit hours

Additional Information

This tuition waiver does not include student fees and only covers the non-resident portion of tuition, up to the awarded amount. Students are not eligible to receive more than one tuition waiver.

Certification
